WiMAX, also known as IEEE 802.16e, is a wireless technology standard that offers users speeds comparable to wireline technologies, like cable and DSL, with the mobility of traditional cellular voice services. Xanadoo has rights to 2.5 GHz licenses covering approximately 8 million people in Texas, Arkansas, Illinois, Kansas, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, Oklahoma and West Virginia. Xanadoo is also a licensee of 700 MHz spectrum covering almost 156 million people in major markets, such as New York, Boston, Philadelphia, Pittsburgh, Cleveland, Detroit, Chicago, Miami, Tampa, San Francisco, Sacramento, Portland and Seattle.
